The **St Martin Parish School Board** is participating in the Summer Food Service Program. Meals will be provided to all children 18 years and under or disabled children 19 and over enrolled in a public or private school without charge. Grab and Go meals will not be provided this summer. Children within the community may eat onsite at one of four locations in the District. **Lunch meals are not allowed to leave the premises.** 

Acceptance and participating requirements for the program and all activities are the same for all regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, disability, age, or reprisal or retaliation for prior civil rights activity in any program or activity conducted or funded by USDA, and there will be no discrimination in the course of the meal service.

Summer Feeding will start on Monday, June 6, 2022, and end on Friday, July 1, 2022, for Cecilia Primary, St. Martinville Primary, and Stephensville Elementary. Breaux Bridge Primary will end on Thursday, July 28, 2022.
